Your guide to our local area

Tottenham Hotspur Football Club and its Stadium sit at the heart of one of London's most culturally diverse communities with a fascinating history and rich heritage.

This is reflected through a thriving food and arts scene and innovative range of small businesses, making Tottenham a vibrant cultural hub. Its proud history is showcased across its local parks, green spaces and listed buildings, providing further inspiration for local creatives.

Tottenham Hotspur Stadium has been the catalyst in creating a sport, leisure and entertainment destination, welcoming visitors from across the world throughout the year.

In addition to being the home of Tottenham Hotspur, the Stadium is the official home of the NFL in the UK and has staged international rugby finals, world heavyweight championship boxing and some of the world's best known artists in concert, including global superstars Beyonce, Lady Gaga and Travis Scott.

A range of visitor attractions including F1 DRIVE – the world's first in-stadium karting facility - and the Dare Skywalk - enabling guests to scale the height of the Stadium for breathtaking views of London – as well as conference and events spaces, bring hundreds to the area on a daily basis.

An in-depth analysis of Tottenham Hotspur's socio economic impact, published by EY in 2023, found that the opening of the Stadium in 2019 has been a landmark event in the uplift of the area. The Club contributes £900m of gross output to London's economy and £344m GVA (gross value added) in the tri-borough of Haringey, Enfield and Waltham Forest, with around 4,000 jobs supported by the Stadium and further growth expected for the coming years.

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FOOD AND DRINK

[The Antwerp Arms](#)

168-170 Church Road, N17 8AS
(0.4 miles, 9 minute walk)

'The Annie' is the oldest working pub in N17 and has been a firm fan favourite since 1882. The Antwerp Arms became north London's first community pub in 2015 after it was saved from being sold to developers by Spurs supporters, the Club and local people.

[Blooming Scent Café](#)

639 High Road, N17 8AA (0.3 miles, 7 minute walk)

Gina's family-owned Blooming Scent Café serves a succulent fusion of African, Caribbean and English cuisine using fresh and natural ingredients to ensure dishes are rich in colour and flavour. It also serves a range of cocktails and coffee and is a great place to meet friends before visiting the Stadium.

[Brown Eagle Restaurant](#)

741 High Road, N17 8AG (0.1 miles, 1 minute walk)

A firm favourite of event-goers, Brown Eagle serves authentic Caribbean dishes and cocktails across the road from Tottenham Hotspur Stadium. Perfect for your pre-event meal.



[Bruce Burgers](#)

93 Bruce Grove, N17 8AG (0.7 miles, 15 minute walk)

Whether you're a devoted meat lover or vegan/vegetarian, Bruce Burgers in Bruce Grove offers a diverse Caribbean inspired menu with something for everyone from flavorsome burgers, to chops and wings, to mac 'n' cheese. A short walk from the Stadium, Bruces Burgers also shows live sports.

[Café Lemon](#)

118 West Green Road, N15 5AA (1.5 miles, 35 minute walk)

Located on the trendy West Green Road, Café Lemon has a cool ambience and serves great food and coffee. Lunch, brunch and main dishes available as well as cakes and Turkish coffee. An excellent brunch spot and you can be sure of a warm welcome.



[Chick King](#)

755 High Road, N17 8AH (0.1 miles, 3 minute walk)

The legendary Chick King is a Tottenham institution and is one of London's best known chicken shops. A firm favourite of generations of Spurs fans, visitors travel from far and wide to sample their legendary fried chicken.

[Chuku's Nigerian Tapas](#)

274 High Road, N15 4AJ (1 mile, 25 minute walk)

Chuku's is the world's first Nigerian tapas restaurant, founded by a brother-sister duo who have made a home in Tottenham. They are one of the many success stories of the area's regeneration which now has a thriving food scene. The restaurant is hugely popular on major event days and famously benefited from Beyonce's 2023 residency at Tottenham Hotspur Stadium, winning an £8,000 grant from the singer's BeyGOOD foundation designed to help innovative small Black-owned businesses.

[Cinnamon Leaf Food Hall](#)

555 High Road, N17 6SD (0.6 miles, 12 minute walk)

A family owned organic whole food grocery and coffee shop with an artisan bakery and deli. Featured in Time Out, Cinnamon Leaf Food Hall promotes healthy eating and sustainable living with a focus on Caribbean cuisine and culture.

[Beavertown Corner Pin pub](#)

723 High Road, N17 0AG (0.1 miles, 1 minute walk)

The historic Corner Pin pub, located on the corner of Park Lane, was restored by the Club in 2021 in partnership with local brewery Beavertown. Its history as a pub dates back to 1871. Now fully renovated and restored, the Corner Pin offers a range of drinks and is open every match and event day.

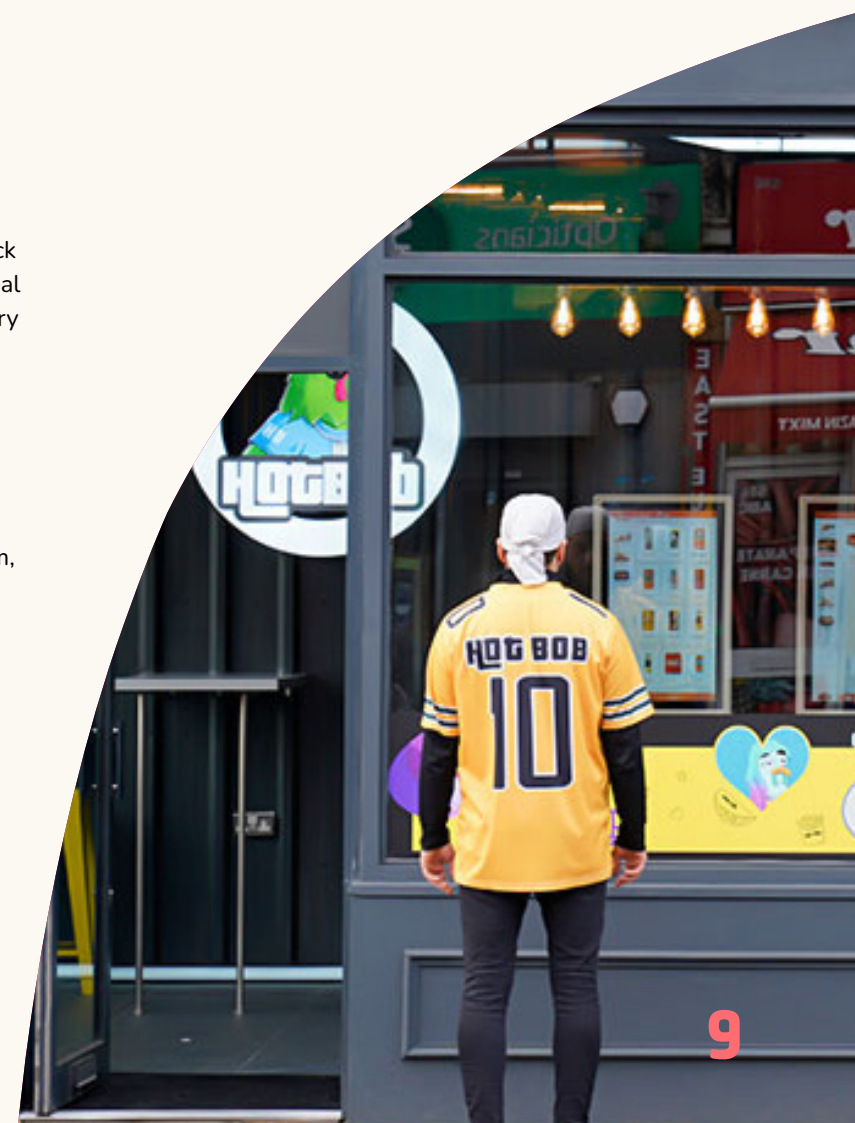

HotBob's flame-grilled pieces are the stuff of legend, boasting juicy, spicy goodness that keeps fans coming back for more. Crafted with care and using only the freshest, real ingredients, Hob Bob's sauces and marinades elevate every bite to perfection.

[Holcombe Market](#)

1 Holcombe Road, N17 9AA (0.8 miles, 17 minute walk)

Holcombe Market is nestled within the heart of Tottenham, close to Bruce Grove Station. Originally established over 100 years ago, this historic market site was relaunched in 2016 and is now a thriving hub of authentic food and culture. It offers everything from seasonal fruit and vegetables, fresh fish, a wide selection of cheese and charcuterie, artisan cakes and local street food.



Mother Hubbard's Fish & Chips

771 High Road, N17 8AH (0.1 miles, 1 minute walk)

Located across the road from Tottenham Hotspur Stadium, Mother Hubbard's golden and crispy haddock and use of only the finest British farmed white potatoes for their fluffy golden chips are a firm favourite of football fans and event-goers.

Mother Kelly's

Unit 1, Rosa Luxemburg Apartments, 16 Ashley Road, N17 9ST (1.2 miles, 25 minute walk)

A stone's throw from Tottenham Hale station, Mother Kelly's is an assortment of tap rooms that specialise in offering delicious beer from the finest independent breweries. Their Tottenham venue is housed in a beautifully refurbished, glass warehouse with 9M high ceilings. Excellent service, quality drinks, and an ever-changing menu of beers on tap – what's not to love!

Pasero

120a West Green Road, N15 5AA (1.5 miles, 35 minute walk)

A restaurant, wine bar and café located just a short walk from Seven Sisters station. Pasero offers freshly baked bread, coffee and pastries by day and a rotating roster of guest chefs by night. Their eclectic and ever-changing menu in a relaxed and intimate ambience makes it a must visit.

The Bluecoats Pub

614 High Road, N17 9TA (0.5 miles, 10 minute walk)

Built on the site of the former Bluecoats School for Girls on Tottenham High Road, this 1830s building was restored and reopened as a pub in summer 2018. Set over two floors and with a front garden, Bluecoats has a great selection of drinks and some of the best burgers and wings in north London. It also hosts a number of events, live music performances, DJs and sports screenings.

The High Cross

350 High Road, N17 9HT (1.1 miles, 25 minute walk)

Craft beer, wine, spirits and delicious pub food close to Seven Sisters station. This micropub is located in a former

Hale Village, Waterside Way, N17 9FU (1.6 miles, 34 minute walk)

Table 13 in Hale Village is a bakery, café and wine bar serving outstanding coffee, fresh sourdough bread, pastries, sandwiches and pizza. By night it transforms into a wine bar, serving 13 wines by the glass paired with delicious small plates.

The Post Bar

36 High Road, N15 4BN (1.1 miles, 25 minute walk)

A live music venue with an Argentinian grill, the Post Bar is a late night venue showing live sport. A great place to meet friends for a burger or a craft beer before heading to the Stadium.

True Craft Tottenham

65 West Green Road, N15 5NR (1.5 miles, 35 minute walk)

With a combined passion for great beer and sourdough pizza, sibling duo David and Oz set up True Craft in 2018 in an old Victorian pub on West Green Road. It is now one of the liveliest spots in Tottenham on event days welcoming visitors from far and wide.

The Victoria Pub

34 Scotland Green, N17 9TT (0.5 miles, 11 minute walk)

A match and event day favourite, The Victoria is a traditional British pub and community venue with craft beers, pool tables, live music and regular DJs. Big screens throughout the pub showing live sport and a weekly pub quiz make this a must visit on any trip to N17.

WingLab

645 High Road N17 8AA
(0.3 miles, 6 minute walk)

The best chicken wings in London, Wing Lab's menu boasts an extensive selection of chicken wings, from classic favourites like their crispy buttermilk marinated chicken to unique creations combining bold flavours.

804A High Road (0.1 miles, 1 minute walk)

Perfect pre-match or pre-event, 3 points serves a delicious range of breakfast and lunch options as well as teas and coffees a stone's throw from Tottenham Hotspur Stadium.

White Rose restaurant

864 High Road (0.2 miles, 3 minute walk)

White Rose is the best place for Mediterranean food in North London. Their menu features a range of dishes inspired by the flavours and cooking techniques of Turkey and the Mediterranean region. From delicious kebabs and grilled seafood to mouthwatering vegetarian options.



PLACES OF INTEREST

Bernie Grant Arts Centre

*Town Hall Approach Road, Tottenham Green, N15 4RX
(1.2 miles, 26 minute walk)*

Bernie Grant Arts Centre is a performance and event venue in the heart of Tottenham, inspired by the area's legendary former MP. The purpose-built complex opened in 2007, comprising a 274-seat theatre, multi-purpose studio spaces, boutique cinema, enterprise units and an award winning café and bar.

Beavertown Brewery

Unit 17 Lockwood Industrial Park N17 9QP (1.6 miles, 34 minute walk)

The Club's Official Craft Beer Supplier, Beavertown, is the largest independent craft brewer in London, and sits at the heart of London's growing craft beer scene. Located less than two miles from our stadium, the Taproom bar at Beavertown's brewery is the place to go for alfresco beers in Tottenham.

Bruce Castle Museum and Park

Lordship Lane, Tottenham, N17 8NL (0.5 miles, 11 minute walk)

A 16th century manor house and local history museum with over 1,000 years of stories. It houses Haringey's local history collections, archives and exhibitions and hosts regular historical and art events. The park was created from the remains of the ancient Bruce Castle family estate covering 8 hectares of parkland.

Drumsheds

Meridian Water, Argon Road, N18 3BW (1.4 miles, 32 minute walk)

Located in a former gasworks, Drumsheds is a unique 15,000 capacity venue that has been revived as a pioneering and multi-purpose event space for large-scale indoor and outdoor music and cultural events. It has hosted some of the biggest names in dance music.





[Roller Nation](#)

(0.7 miles, 17 minute walk)

Roller Nation is London's premier roller-skating disco, a great place to let your hair down and enjoy an amazing night out with friends. In addition to their roller rink, Roller Nation has a diner, bar, garden area and seating booths to create the perfect balance between skating activity and relaxing.

[Seven Sisters Market \(Latin Village\)](#)

(1.6 miles, 34 minute walk)

An indoor market and multicultural hub with latin American shops and restaurants. The market has become an important meeting place for the Latin American community in London with traders from across South America including Colombia, Peru, Chile, Ecuador, and Brazil.

33 Queen Street, N17 8JA (0.7 miles, 15 minute walk)

Wildes Cheese is an award-winning independent artisan cheese-making company based in the heart of Tottenham. Its range of courses, dubbed one of The Guardian's top foodie courses in the UK, teach you the art of cheese-making and how the process can be replicated at home. [The Dare Skywalk & Edge](#)

See London from new heights and take in breathtaking panoramic views of the city by scaling the Tottenham Hotspur Stadium! The Dare Skywalk offers visitors a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to step out onto a glass walkway suspended 46.8 meters above the pitch and take a walk around Tottenham Hotspur's iconic golden cockerel. For the bravest thrill seekers, you can skip the stairs as you head back down to solid ground, by combining your Skywalk with the Edge and abseiling to Park Lane Square below.

[F1 DRIVE – London](#)

The world's first in-stadium karting experience! At F1 DRIVE – London, you're in the driver's seat of the capital's most thrilling experience. Engineered with F1 technology, it's time to test your skills across an exciting track layout from behind the wheel of bespoke F1 inspired karts, featuring DRS technology, engine sounds and an 18cm LED streeting wheel display.

PARKS AND GREEN SPACES

Chestnuts Park

St Ann's Road, West Green, N15 5BN (2 miles, 45 minute walk)

A great place to visit for people of all ages. It features an open playing field, a café and picnic area, an outdoor gym, free tennis courses and a multi-use games area. The Park also has a community willow garden and orchard of 21 fruit trees.

Downhills Park

West Green Road, West Green, N15 3RB (1.5 miles, 35 minute walk)

An award winning 12-hectare park, it has an open recreation space and a managed garden area that includes a rose garden, tennis courts and a playground. Near the tennis courts is the [Downhills Park Cafe](#), a social enterprise which supports adults with learning disabilities into employment.



Markfield Park

Crowland Road, London, N15 6UL (2 miles, 45 minute walk)

First created as a park in 1929, Markfield Park is nearly 20 acres in size, with the River Lea running through, and features a large open lawn as well as a walking path, café and steam engine museum.

New River Sports and Fitness

White Hart Lane, Wood Green, N22 5QW (1.5 miles, 35 minute walk)

One of the area's most versatile sporting venues, New River offers a range of excellent facilities, including 3G pitches for 5,7 and 11-a-side football, plus indoor and outdoor tennis courts.

Tottenham Marshes

Watermead Way, London, N17 0XD (1.2 miles 26 minute walk)

Nature reserve including cycling and walking routes, wildflower meadows and accessible river channels. Tottenham marshes is home to a range of insects and wildlife, including Kingfishers. A must-visit for all lovers of nature and the outdoors.

Uncle John's Bakery

Uncle John's Bakery is the UK's No.1 Ghanian bakery and has had a home on West Green Road for 25 years. Having grown from a husband and wife team to a family business, the bakery has become a leading supplier to national supermarket chains and a wholesaler. They are nationally recognised as the very first bakery in the UK to supply Ghanian sweetbread.

J Reid Pianos

J Reid pianos is a family-run business repairing and selling pianos in St Ann's Road, Tottenham for generations. It is the last remaining piano factory in London and houses over 50 grand pianos in their Tottenham showroom.

Sarabande Foundation, established by the late designer Alexander McQueen, has nurtured more than 200 artists and designers from multiple cultural disciplines. Sarabande expanded to Tottenham in 2022, with 15 new studios and an exhibition space. Its mission is to help artists, craftsmen, and designers realise their bold visions. The foundation sits on the High Road as part of Paxton17 – the new creative quarter in Tottenham.



Sands and Randall

Ashley Sands and Robert Randall are woodcarving specialists who set up Sands and Randall in 2000. Their work encompasses architectural woodcarving, historic restoration, and gilding. They have made carvings for contemporary artists, for St Paul's Cathedral, the Globe Theatre, the Victoria & Albert Museum, the National Trust and English Heritage.

F3 Architects
